FORWARD VIRGINIA: PHASE III SWIMMING POOLS

Mandatory requirements related to physical distancing, enhanced cleaning and disinfection procedures, enhanced workplace safety practices.

Signage that no one with a fever or symptoms of Covid-19, or known exposure to COVID-19 case in prior 14 days is permitted.

Facilities should screen patrons for COVID-19 symptoms prior to admission to the facility. Anyone experience symptoms should not be permitted in the facility.

Interactive play features (e.g., splash pads and spray pools) must be closed.

Pool may be open at up to 75% occupancy provided ten feet of social distancing may be maintained between patrons not of the same household

Free swim is allowed.


Instruction and water exercise classes limited to allow all participants to maintain ten feet of physical distance where practicable. **Parents or guardians may support a participant during class, and instructors may have contact with participants when necessary.**

Seating may be provided with at least 10 feet of spacing between persons who are not members of the same household.

All seating must be cleaned and disinfected between uses.

Employees working in customer-facing areas are required to wear face coverings.

Pool must provide hand sanitizing stations at entrance/exit and where shared equipment is utilized.



OPENING DAY: HPP OPERATING PROCEDURES (PHASE III)

Capacity. Facility capacity cannot exceed 130 patrons; no guests during 2020 season.

Masks. Lifeguards are required to wear masks; they are not required while not on duty. Patrons are strongly encouraged to wear masks inside the bathhouse.

COVID-19 Certification. Upon entry to the facility, members will be required to certify that each member of his/her household is COVID-19 symptom-free.

The Hurricane Hut, Highland Beach, and basketball court will remain closed.

Active members in good standing will have an opportunity to reserve times for recreational free swim/tennis via SignUp Genius.

Members assume all responsibility for cleaning and disinfecting deck furniture and picnic tables before/after each use.

New entry and exit procedures.

Members are discouraged from using the bathrooms for showering/changing.

Seating will be arranged daily to provided with at least 10 feet of spacing between persons who are not members of the same household.



ENTRY AND EXIT PROCEDURES

Enter the facility through the front gate. Safe distancing points are indicated in green/blue HPP markings

Upon entry, member must present his/her membership card to the front desk attendant.

As a condition of entry, members must certify the following:

Neither me nor any members of my household are currently experiencing any of the following: a fever (100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher) or has a sense of having a fever; a new cough that cannot be attributed to another healthy conditions; new chills that cannot be attributed to another health condition; a new sore through that cannot be attributed to another condition; and/or new muscle aches that cannot be attributed to another health condition or specific activity.

Front desk attendant will record the certifications and maintain the records at the front desk.

Members must proceed into the pool through the middle gages.

Members will exit through the tennis courts/picnic area.

RECREATIONAL SWIMMING PROCEDURES

Reservations for recreational swim will be released every Sunday at 9 pm to active members in good standing.


Two-hour reservations will be offered at the following times: 11 A.M.; 1:30 P.M.; 4 P.M.; and 6:30 P.M. Please be mindful of your fellow members and limit your signups to one slot per day.

Reservations will be held for 15 minutes. Thereafter, walk-ins will be accommodated on a first-come, first-serve basis through the front desk attendant.

Lifeguards will call a **10-minute break every 50 minutes**; children under the age of 16 must clear the pool.

Lifeguards will signal a 5-minutes warning to indicate the end of a reservation block; members are expected to exit the pool and facility at the end of the session.


Members are strongly encouraged to maintain 10 feet distance between non-household members at all times. **Lifeguards will not enforce social distancing.**



HPP TENNIS PROCEDURES

Tennis is limited to one court and will be for tennis only.

90 minute reservations will be offered at the following times: 11 A.M.;
12:45 P.M.; 2:30 P.M.; 4:15 P.M. 6:00 P.M. and 7:45 P.M.



OTHER PROCEDURES

Deck arrangements will be grouped daily with 10 feet between each seating area.

HPP will provide disinfectants for pool deck furniture. **Members must disinfect pool deck furniture before and after each use.**

Members are permitted to bring their own chairs for their own personal use.

High touch areas (handrails, ladders, diving rails, doorknobs) will be cleaned regularly.

Manager on duty will be the COVID-19 resource contact for members. A board member will be on-call for emergencies.

SWIM/DIVE CONDITIONING PROGRAMS

Swim and dive conditional program offered from July 6-August 7, 2020.

Participation is open to all members and participants can be involved in both programs.

Eligibility Requirements for Swim/Dive Programs.

Swim Schedule:

- * 18 swimmers per session
- * 7:30 – 8:15 AM (9 & UNDER); 8:30 – 9:15 AM (10-12); 9:30 – 10:15 (13-17)

Dive Schedule

- * 18 divers per session
- * 7:45 – 9:00 AM (10 & under); 9:00-10:15 AM (11 & up)

Cost:

- * \$110 to participate in both programs
